****ACCT 3310 Business Processes & Internal Controls is not required for MAcc or GCA applicants who completed accounting degrees at another institution prior to enrolling at Auburn. Students who enroll in the Auburn Bridge or BSBA Accounting programs will be required to take ACCT 3310.**

IMPORTANT NOTES:

To be eligible for the Auburn MAcc or GCA Programs, candidates must have a four-year undergraduate degree from an accredited university. Candidates must have also completed the business and accounting foundation courses outlined above from a U.S. institution.

The Auburn MAcc Program is a professional non-thesis degree program requiring 30 semester hours of coursework. All students (both on-campus and online) are required to participate in a three day campus residency while enrolled in the last spring semester of the program. The campus residency is a graduation requirement.

The GCA Program requires 18 semester hours of graduate accounting coursework taught in the MAcc Program. The GMAT is not required for the GCA program. Students who successfully complete the GCA may matriculate to the MAcc program without a GMAT score. Nearing completion of the GCA, students will be required to submit an application to the MAcc program.
